1. Eligibility Conditions.

If the candidate has English but no Maths/Accts/Book Keeping as subject in 12 th he should have passed class 10 th with min 40% marks in Maths/Accts/Book Keeping. Similarly if candidate has Maths/Accts/Book Keeping in class 12 th but no English, he should have passed class 10 th with min 40% marks in English. (c) If a candidate is a graduate (any field) with Maths/Accountancy/ Book keeping and English (even elective) as one of the subjects, the stipulation of scoring 40% marks in Math/ English in class XII or class X and scoring 50% marks in aggregate in class XII is waived off. (d) If a candidate is a graduate but not having English and Math/Accountancy/Book Keeping at graduate level, he should have scored minimum 40% marks in English and Math/Accountancy/Book Keeping at least once in class XII or class X.

National Trade Certificate issued by National Council for Vocational Training will be the authority for ITI qualification.

Note:-

- (a) In addition to the original education certificates as per eligibility for category chosen by the candidate, they will also bring original education certificates of their highest qualification.
- (b) Candidates with 10+2 Vocational Subjects <u>are not eligible</u> for Soldier Technical, Soldier Nursing Assistant, Soldier Clerk /Store Keeper Technical and Soldier General Duty. They can apply for Soldier Tradesmen.
- (c) Candidates who are below 18 years of age will bring their parents consent certificate.
- (d) Sportsmen who have represented India at International level and State at National level but not earned 1st/2nd position are eligible for relaxation in physical standards and bonus marks as per laid down policies on the subject.
- (e) Sportsmen who have represented District at State level and University team or Regional team at District level will be eligible for physical relaxation and bonus marks only in case they have earned 1st/2nd position.

2. <u>Age Group</u>. Age of the candidate will be counted as on **01 Oct 2016.** The minimum age criteria for candidates will be as under:-

3. Other Conditions.

- (a) Indian Army affords certain relaxation towards SOS/SOEX/SOW/SOWW for recruitment based on issue of Relationship Certificate by concerned Records Office, duly signed by an officer indicating the full details of the officer signing viz Personal No, Rank, Name and Appointment.
- (b) Married candidates below 21 years of age are NOT eligible for enrolment into Army.
- (c) Candidates who have undertaken Class X Board Examination would be considered for screening of Soldier General Duty and Solider Tradesman Categories only.
- (d) <u>Tattoo / Engraving</u>. Permanent body tattoos are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e. from inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm/back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body is not acceptable and candidate will be barred from further selection.
- 4. <u>Selection Procedure</u>. The under mentioned tests are compulsory for all:-
 - (a) **Physical Fitness Test.**
 - (i) 1.6 km Run.
 - (ii) 9 Feet Ditch Jump.
 - (iii) Pull Ups.
 - (iv) Zig-zag Balance.
 - (b) **Physical Measurement Test.** As per eligibility requirement of category given at Para 3.
 - (c) <u>Medical</u>. After completion of Physical Fitness Test successful candidates will have to go through Medical Examination. The Medical Examination will be carried out on subsequent dates by Medical Teams. Candidates have to check for date of Medical Examination at rally site on the day of PFT/PMT.
 - (d) <u>Common Entrance Examination.</u> All the candidates except DSC candidates who have been declared fit in the Medical Examination will undergo a Common Entrance Examination. Date and venue for CEE will be announced at rally site or will be intimated separately.
- 5. <u>Documents Required</u>. Candidates are advised to bring the following documents in original on the day of Rally as per programme. The documents should be laminated, arranged properly in a sequence and contained in a file cover, alongwith one set of Photostat copies of each duly attested by a Gazetted Officer with his name and seal in ENGLISH. Candidates are advised to check their certificates and Marks Sheet for mismatch of names, DOB, Parents name, School and other particulars in various certificates. Nativity, Community Certificate and 10th class certificate are the basic documents. All documents/rubber stamps/seals should be in English.
 - (a) SSLC Mark Sheet.
 - (b) Intermediate Mark Sheet, where applicable.
 - (c) Degree Mark Sheet, where applicable.
 - (d) Nativity (issue date of certificate should not be earlier than six months) and Community Certificate in English duly signed by Tehsildar or Revenue Officer with his name and seal in English with affixed individual photo duly attested. Any cutting/alteration will not be accepted.
 - (e) All candidates will bring an Affidavit duly signed by the candidate on Stamp paper and attested by a Notary (format attached).
 - (f) All candidates will bring e-Government nativity certificate with photo attached and attested by Tehsildar only.
 - (g) Study and Conduct Certificate from last Educational Institute in English.
 - (h) Character Certificate from Village Administrative Officer in English (issue date of certificate should not be earlier than six months).
 - (j) Transfer certificate in original in English / Bonafide certificate from school/college if candidate is studying.
 - (k) NCC/Sports/ITI & Computer certificate of O⁺⁺ level, if held.

- (I) Twelve latest coloured 34mm x 45mm passport size photographs with name and DOB of candidates printed on photographs not taken earlier than one month. Other types of photograph will not be accepted.
- (m) <u>Non Matric</u> In case of Non Matric Candidates, Transfer Certificate duly verified by the District Education Officer and Mark Sheets of 8th Class duly affixed with school seal and attested by Headmaster. Seal and language should be in English. Only those candidates who have scored min 33% marks in each subject in class 8th are eligible.

(n) Son of Serviceman/Ex-Servicemen.

- (i) In case of son of serving soldier of JCO/NCO or Officer. Relationship certificate duly signed by Chief Record Officer/Senior record Officer of respective Record Office with date of birth, joint photographs of the candidate with his father.
- (ii) In case of Son of Ex-Servicemen, relationship certificate duly signed by Chief Record Officer / Senior Record Officer of respective Record Office. The certificate must indicate, whether the son was born during service/after retirement. Also, combined Certificate of Discharge or Transfer to reserve and recommendation for civil Employment (IAFY-1964) will be produced as a provisional document for screening.
- 6. Pay and Allowances and other Facilities. After enrollment, a soldier is entitled to get approximate monthly emoluments of Rs24,000/- PM including allowances as admissible alongwith other facilities such as Free Ration/Ration Money, Clothing, Medical for self and dependents, Accommodation and Railway Warrant for self and dependents, Group Housing Scheme, Army Group Insurance Scheme of Rs 25,00,000/-. Fully paid Annual Leave of 60 days, Casual Leave 30 days, Medical Leave as recommended by medical authority and Leave Encashment 30 days in a calendar year and upto maximum 300 days in service.
- 7. **Pension.** Service pension is admissible to an individual on completion of mandatory minimum service and subject to rank.
- 8. **Promotion.** Departmental opportunities to become an Officer/Junior Commissioned Officer subject to certain conditions are available.

9. **Advisory**.

- (a) Candidates are advised to be self contained for food and water on the day of documentation, the day of screening and the medical days. No one will be allowed to go out of rally ground/Stadium during the documentation / screening / medical test.
- (b) Candidates are advised to report to the rally site strictly as per date given in admit card, to avoid over crowding and unnecessary waiting at rally site.
- (c) Candidates are advised to take care of their documents / belongings against theft during rally.
- (d) No mobiles, tablets and calculators are permitted at rally site.

10. Caution to all Candidates.

- (a) Candidates are to be aware that on enrolment into the Indian Army, there will be certain implications and restrictions on the Fundamental Rights guaranteed to him by the Constitution of India as per provision of the Army Act (1950) and Army Rule (1954). The candidate will also have to furnish an undertaking to this effect during enrolment.
- (b) All candidates are warned against the use of performance enhancing drugs during Physical Proficiency Test. Candidates are liable to be screened for use of physical performance enhancing drugs during recruitment rally. Dope positive candidates will be disqualified.
- (c) Candidates have to furnish a declaration certificate at the time of enrolment for not engraving any permanent tattoo on the body during entire service.
- (d) Army will not be responsible for any injury or death caused to any candidate during recruitment rally. The candidates will participate at their own risk.
- (e) Recruitment is a free service and candidates are cautioned against falling victim to unscrupulous elements/ middlemen/agents/touts. Paying money to agents/touts is a crime. Candidates are advised not to waste time and money on such activity, no one can help except their own hard work and merit.
- (f) Biometric identification and hand writing analysis is done at each stage. Imposters will be caught and handed over to police.
- (g) Use of any unfair means will make the candidate liable for disqualification at all stages of recruitment whenever found. He will be handed over to police thereafter.
- (h) In order to implement the new system of marking in Common Entrance Examination, each question is graded for 02 marks and every wrong answer is awarded negative ½ mark i.e. -0.5 mark for Soldier General Duty and Soldier Tradesmen only. For Soldier Clerk/ Store Keeper Technical and Soldier Technical, each question is graded for 04 marks and every wrong answer is awarded negative 1 mark i.e. -1.0 mark. Soldier Nursing Assistant, each question is graded 02 marks and every wrong answer is negative ½ mark i.e. -0.5 mark.
- (j) Production of fake certificates and making of false declaration will lead to cancellation of candidature and criminal prosecution under law.

- (k) Military service is a volunteer service.
